



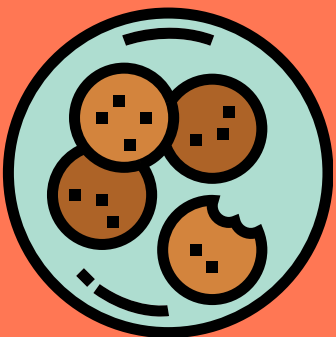
## WELCOME NEW NEIGHBORS
